FREE Downloadable Forms for Washington state residents to complete and return with photo identification to a County Clerk's office in any county of Washington State to confidentially restrict immediate access to firearm purchases and to eliminate impulsive suicide attempts.

FREE Downloadable Forms for Washington state residents to complete and return to a County Clerk's office in any county of Washington State to petition for protection when an individual's behavior indicates substantial risk of suicide or harm to self or to others.

Unit is responsible for quickly and proactively assisting with the service of protection orders, immediate removal of firearms based on those orders, and holding those accountable who fail to comply with or who otherwise possess firearms unlawfully.
