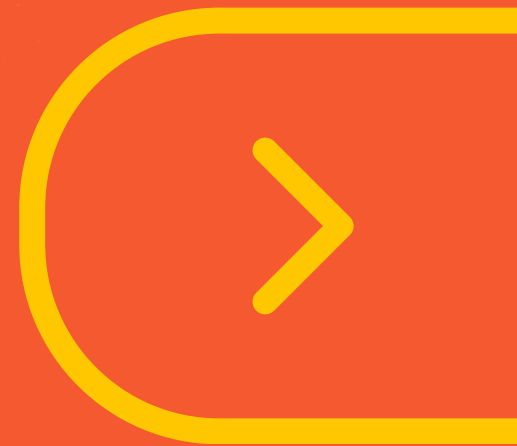

CALL 9-1-1

**Ask for help in case of
emergency —
Stay calm and give them your
address with landmarks.**

STOP, DROP, & ROLL

**If your clothes were to catch
on fire —**

**Stop what you're doing, drop
to the floor, and roll.**

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STAY THREE FEET AWAY

**Keep kids and pets at least
three feet away from heat
sources.**

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KEEP WATER NEARBY

**Have a bucket of water & fire
extinguishing equipment
readily available for use.**

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BEWARE OF FIRE HAZARDS

**Watch stoves, outdoor grills,
fire pits, and campfires —
Never leave them unattended.**

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
